Community Alert

Everyone is familiar with the notices about Clonown Community Alert which appear at the roadside in various places in Clonown. Some may not be aware that senior citizens can obtain a phone with large numbers for dialling, a sensor light and a pendant worn around the neck which can be used for raising the alarm in the case of accident, illness or a break in. In an emergency the button on the pendant can be pressed and a central system will contact a family member or neighbour. Monitoring is free for the first year with an annual fee of around €80 after that. The pendant is effective both inside and outside the house. Besides having these items installed, people will be shown how to use them. Those who already have the system can have an upgrade. For further information please contact Johnnie at 6493048.
