They became lifelong friends and he attributes his vocation to Sr Gemma. As a young student, Cardinal Dolan visited Sr Gemma in her convent and she brought him to Curnaboll. Last year, she was visited by the cardinal while he was in Ireland on special papal business and at her funeral the Bishop of Meath, Dr Michael Smith, conveyed the condolences of the Cardinal to her family. Of interest also is the fact that the cardinal was one of those frequently mentioned as a possible choice of the cardinals in the recent papal election.
