It has been a busy few months. Drum/Clonown Community Games became the first sports group to use the pitch when they trained in July. Clonown Rovers FC

celebrated its 40th anniversary with a game on the 25 July against a Clonown Legends team. They played for the Gary Noone Cup. Clonown Rovers had their first competitive game on Sunday 23 August. They won their game against Killoe FC 4 - 1.

The committee submitted an expression of interest to Roscommon Leader earlier in the year for funding for the children's play area. Roscommon Leader has indicated that it is hoped to have full approval of its couny programme in October and applications can be made after that.
